# CODICIL

I, Ludmilla Rothammer, of the City of Medford, Taylor County, Wisconsin, declare this to be a codicil of my Will, which bears date the 19th day of February, 1948, whereas by my said Will the first paragraph thereaf reads as follows:

\*FIRST, I will and direct that my executor hereinafter named, to first pay all my just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my death as may be conveniently done."

Now I hereby provide that in lieu of said paragraph, there be substituted the following paragraph:
