CHAPTER TWENT-FOUR

William Henry Decker, Jr. William And Margaretta Decker's Son

William Henry Decker was born November 27, 1864 in New Jersey,¹ presumably, Taylor Town, Pequannock Township, Morris County. William Henry Decker's parents were William and Margaretta Decker.² However, no birth records have been found for William Henry Decker; therefore, it is not known where he was born in New Jersey or exactly who his parents were. William Henry Decker is presumed to have been born in Taylor Town, Pequannock Township, Morris County because that is where his sisters, Rachell and Rossella were born.³ Actually, there is no direct proof that the parents of Rachel and Rossella Decker, (i.e. William and Margaretta Decker) are the same people who gave birth to William Henry Decker, i.e. William and Margaretta Decker. It is possible that were two sets of parents, each with the name William and Margaretta Decker. Still, there is a reasonable amount of evidence to indicate that William Henry Decker's parents were in fact the parents of Rachel and Rossella Decker.⁴

There are only five documents which reference William Decker marriage to Margaretta Preston. Two documents are birth records for Rachell and Rossella Decker. These documents indicate that a William Decker and Margaretta Preston where Rachell and Rossella Decker's parents. These documents do not prove that William Decker and Margaretta Preston were William Henry Decker's parents. The other two documents consist of William Henry Decker' Obituary and death certificate. William Henry Decker's death certificate and obituary indicates he was born November 27, 1864 in New Jersey and his parents were William Decker and Maragretta Preston. The information in the obituary and death certificate was provided by William Henry Decker's children. Naturally, they would have received the information from their parents, William Henry and Eliza Jane Decker. Still, the information in William Henry Decker'Os obituary and death certificate may not be reliable since his children may not have received correct information. The last document is the marriage record for William Henry Decker and Eliza Jane Hare. That document indicates that William Henry Decker's parents were Wm Decker and Margaretta Preston. The marriage record should be reliable since William Henry Decker would have provided the information himself and he certainly should have known whether the information was true.

It is thought that William Henry Decker's father died, or divorced his wife, Margaretta. However, no death record, divorce document or any other document, except for one, has been found which indicates what happened to William Henry Decker's father, William Decker.

There is a probate document which provides some evidence to support the argument that William Henry Decker's father died. During the probate of Phebe Adkins' Will in 1890, the Executor of her will, Ward Akins, set forth Phebe's next of kin in a Proof of Heirship. Among those identified were the children of Phebe Adkins' deceased son, William Decker. The children were identified as [Zulah?] Decker, granddaughter; William Decker, grandson and Rachel Decker, granddaughter. Zulah Decker may be a misspelled version of Rossella Decker's name. Rossella Decker may have also been known as Ursula or Ersula, and therefore, Zulah may have been a misspelled version of Ursula or Ersula.

In any case, by 1868 Margaretta Preston-Decker had moved to Kingston Township, Dekalb County, Illinois with her children, Rachel Decker, William Decker and probably Rosella Decker. Margaretta (Preston) Decker married Royal S. Fuller on April 21, 1866 in Dekalb County⁹ and had two children with him. The Census of 1870 for Franillin Township shows Margaretta, age 28 living with Royal S. Fuller, age 53. The Census shows that Royal and Joal, age 18, worked in a quarry. Also living in Royal Fuller's household was Rachel Decker, age 7; William Decker, age 5 and Hanna A. Fuller, age 2. Margaretta's daughter, Rossella Decker, is noticeably absent from the Census. The 1870 Census shows that Margaretta, Rachel and William were all born in New Jersey, while Joal M. and Hanna A. were born in Illinois, and everyone in the household is listed as White, not Indian. The 1870 indicates William's race was white, not Indian.

By 1880, William Henry Decker was living with his grandparents, Amasa and Rachel Preston.¹⁷ William was 16 years old, single and a farm laborer.¹⁸ William is identified as Amasa and Rachel Preston's grandson in the 1880 Census.¹⁹

In 1885, William Henry Decker moved to Iowa. William' Obituary states that "He had lived in Buchanan and Fayette counties since 1885."²⁰ It is unknown exactly when William moved to Iowa or for what reason.

On December 16, 1890, William Henry Decker married Eliza Jane Hare.²¹ This date was ten years "prior" to the date identified in Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker' Obituary which was published in the <u>Conservative</u>. The <u>Bulletin Journal</u> only published the year Eliza Jane married William and the year, 1890, was correct. The witnesses to their marriage were Eliza Jane Hare's parents, George and Lucinda Hare.²² When they were married, William Decker was 27 years old and Eliza Jane Hare was 19.²³ Their marriage was the first for both.²⁴ Eliza Jane was William's only wife.²⁵ At the time they were married, William and Eliza Jane were both living in Byron Township, Iowa and William's occupation was farming while no occupation was listed for Eliza Jane.²⁶ Their marriage record identifies William's and Eliza Jane's race and color as White / Caucasian.²⁷ Their marriage record indicates that William Decker was born in New Jersey and that his parents were William Decker and Margaretta Preston.²⁸ Their marriage record also indicates that Eliza Jane Hare was born in Nebraska and her parents were George Hare and Lucinda (Campbell) Hare.²⁹

According to Josephine (Van Laarhoven) Reinhold, Nora (Decker) Reinhold told Josephine that Nora's father's father (William Decker, Sr.) was married to a Sioux, though Josephine doubts there are any records which substantiates the Indian lineage. Still, Josephine (Van Laarhoven) Reinhold, said, she always heard that Nora (Decker) Reinhold was 9/10 of everything, plus 1/10 Sioux.

According to Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns, she always heard that her grandfather, William Henry Decker, had Indian blood in him, possibly Sioux, but she never heard any more information about where the Indian blood came from. In addition, according to Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns, Nora (Decker) Reinhold said, William Decker did not tell his wife, Eliza Jane, about the Indian blood until after they were married. As a result, Eliza Jane would not let her children meet William Decker's other relatives who lived around the Independence area. Further, Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns never did find out who those relatives where.

Lawrence Reinhold did extensive research on William and Margarete Decker's family backgrounds. It appears that Margaretta Anna Preston's first husband was William Decker, Sr. However, there is no evidence of this marriage or where it took place, if it took place. It is assumed that the marriage took place in New Jersey since Margaretta gave birth to William H. Decker, Jr. on November 27, 1864 in New Jersey when she was 20 21 years old, and there are birth records for two girls whose parents were William and Margaret Decker and other information, so it is very likely that Margarete was married to William. Further, Royal Fuller and Margarete Decker's marriage license indicates Margarete's last name was Decker not Preston. Also, no birth record was found for William Henry Decker, but that does not mean that William and Margarete Decker were not his parents. In addition, it is thought that William Decker, Sr. died, divorced or disappeared between March 1864 B March 1865, but there is no proof of this other than he does appear on any records which have been located to date.

Lawrence Reinhold did not find any reference to any Indian heritage in either William Decker's or Margarete (Preston) Decker's background. However, since no records regarding William Henry Decker's birth and no records regarding his father, William Decker, have been found, there is always the possibility that William Henry Decker could have Indian heritage derived from either William Decker's involvement with an Indian women or Margarete (Preston) Decker's involvement with an Indian man. As Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns said, "There were a lot of Indians around at the time." Further, if William Henry Decker was part Indian, he most likely was not broadcasting the information to the World, especially given the times.

Eliza Jane Hare is identified in various documents by different version of her name. She was known as "Jane" by family members. Vital records (births & marriages) for her children either referred to her as "Eliza or Jane." In her obituary published in the <u>The Conservative</u>, the newspaper states that she was born "Ella." Her obituary published in the <u>Bulletin Journal</u> identifies Eliza Jane as "Eliza." William and Eliza Jane Decker's marriage license and Eliza Jane's grave stone both identify her as "Eliza." William Decker's obituary referred to Eliza Jane as "Jane." William's Obituary states "[h]e married Miss Jane Hare. . . ." The reference to "Ella" in the <u>The Conservative</u> is the only source found where Eliza Jane is referred to "Ella." All other references have identified her as Eliza, Eliza Jane, Jane or Liza.

William Decker mostly worked as a laborer through-out his life.³⁰ Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns does not think that he had much of a formal education.³¹ She believes his lack of a formal education was one reason he could never get a good job.³² However, William did drive a car.³³

Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns explained that William Henry Decker tried to farm at least once, but he did not operate the farm very long.³⁴ He farmed land in Fayette County, north of Oran, Iowa.³⁵ He rented the land he was farming.³⁶ He also worked as a farm laborer and was working as a farm laborer when his daughter, Bernice was born.³⁷

William Decker also worked for the railroad companies.³⁸ According to Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns, William told her that, when he was working the railroad section, he would get water from springs by her house south of Hazelton in Buchanan County, Iowa.³⁹ Of course this was before, Clarence and Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kern's owned the farm house.⁴⁰ Carrie Lucille explained that there were springs near their farm house and that small sheds had been built over the springs.⁴¹ She explained that when she and her husband lived on the property, she used the springs as a refrigerator to keep their milk and food cool.⁴²

William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker were more on the quite side and a little hard to get to know.⁴³ However, they were pleasant people and treat their grandchildren well both as children and as adults.⁴⁴

William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker had eight (8) children all of whom are identified in the following two tables. ⁴⁵ There was a 21-year span of time between the oldest and youngest child. Also, William was 8 years older than Eliza Jane.

William H. and Eliza J. (Hare) Decker appear on the 1895 Census for Washington Township, Buchanan County, Iowa with two children. ⁴⁶ William is list as 30 years old and born in New Jersey. ⁴⁷ Eliza is listed as 22 and born in Nebraska. ⁴⁸ Their children (Nora, age 2, and Ella, age 1) are listed as born in Buchanan County, Iowa. ⁴⁹

William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker also appear on the 1900 Census for Washington Township, Buchanan County, Iowa. By 1900, William and Eliza listed four children, though the Census also indicates Eliza was the mother of five living children.⁵⁰ William is listed as 35 years old and head of household.⁵¹ Eliza is listed as Williams wife, age 26.⁵² The Census indicates William and Eliza were married nine (9) years.⁵³ Their children identified in the Census are Nora, age 8, born April 1892; Ella, age 6, born October 1893; Stella, age 5, born October 1894; and Ralph, age 2, born July 1897.⁵⁴ All their children are listed as born in Iowa.⁵⁵ The 1900 Census indicates that William Decker was born November 1864 in New Jersey and that his father and mother were both born in New Jersey.⁵⁶ The Census also indicates that Eliza Decker was born September 1873 in Nebraska and that her father was born in New Jersey while her mother was born in Pennsylvania.⁵⁷

William H. & Eliza J. (Hare)Decker appears on the 1920 Census for Oran Township, Fayette County, Iowa. William is listed as head of household, white, age 53. His occupation is listed as Section Foreman, though the writing is very hard to read. He could read and write English. Willia's parents were born in the United States and William was born in New Jersey. Lucinda? Jis listed as his wife. William's However, her name is extremely difficult to read. Most likely Lucinda J. was Eliza J., William's wife, and therefore, Lucinda will be identified as Eliza in this paragraph. She is identified as white, age 47. She could read and write English, and her occupation is listed as farmer, general farming. Eliza's father was born in New Jersey and her mother was born in Nebraska. Eliza is also shown as having been born in Nebraska. William and Eliza (Hare) Decker's children are identified as Ralph R, age 22; Harvey B., age 19, Bessie I. or L., age 17; Rossie B, age 15 and Mary Ann B., age 7. Mary Ann B. is probably their daughter, Bernice.

William H. and Eliza J. (Hare) Decker appears on the 1930 Census for Oelwein City, Jefferson Township, Fayette County, Iowa.⁷⁰ William is shown with his wife, Jane, and granddaughter, Hilda Miller, age 16.⁷¹ William was 65 years old and Eliza Jane was 57. William is listed as having been born in New Jersey.⁷² William father is listed as having been born in New Jersey.⁷³ Eliza Jane

is listed as having been born in Nebraska.⁷⁴ Her father is listed as having been born in New York and her mother in Pennsylvania.⁷⁵ William's occupation is listed as Foreman–Roundhouse.⁷⁶

Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker was a housewife.⁷⁷ According to Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns, women did not work much outside the home at that time.⁷⁸ Eliza took in washing to earn extra money, but she did not have a garden.⁷⁹ While William and Eliza Jane lived in Oelwein their home was too small to have a garden.⁸⁰ Carrie Lucille thinks that Eliza Jane probably canned food when their children were growing up.⁸¹

Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns went on to explain that William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker moved around quite a bit, but a lot of the moving occurred during the Depression. America's Great Depression is regarded as having begun in 1929 with the Stock Market crash and ended in 1941 with America's entry into World War II. She said, they finally settled down in Oelwein, Iowa. Carrie Lucille went on to say that, during the Depression, William and Eliza Decker's son, Ralph, brought them groceries, and Ralph looked after them for a while during the Depression while they lived in Oelwein, Iowa. Ralph and his wife, Emma, lived in Oelwein for 60 years. Finally, when William's and Eliza's health began to fail, both of them moved to Independence, Buchanan County, Iowa to live with their daughter, Stella Downing.

Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns remembers William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker visiting Carl Oscar and Nora (Decker) Reinhold in Medford, Wisconsin.⁸⁷ She remembers her parents driving William and Eliza around her parents' local area sight-seeing.⁸⁸ However, she does not recall that William and Eliza travel much.⁸⁹ Mostly, William and Eliza stayed around their home area, as Carrie Lucille recalls.⁹⁰

Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker died of a stroke of paralysis on March 4, 1936 at 11:40 pm at her home 7 miles north of Independence, Hazleton Township, Buchannan County, Iowa. Hilliam & Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker were living with their daughter, Stella, at the time Eliza Jane died. Eliza's death record states that she died on March 4, 1936 of a cerebral hemorrhage. Eliza's death record also indicates that she was born September 15, 1872 in

Luella Decker was born October 31, 1893¹¹² in Independence, Buchanan County, Iowa.¹¹³ Luella Decker is identified in various documents by various versions of her name, including Luella Mae Decker,¹¹⁴ Luella May Decker¹¹⁵ and Ella Decker.¹¹⁶ Hereafter, she will be referred to as Ella Decker.

Ella Decker was the daughter of William Henry Decker and Eliza Jane Hare,¹¹⁷ and appears with her parents on the 1895 Census for Washington Township, Buchanan County, Iowa.¹¹⁸ William is listed as 30 years old and born in New Jersey.¹¹⁹ Eliza is listed as 22 and born in Nebraska.¹²⁰ Their children (Nora, age 2 and Ella, age 1) are listed as born in Buchanan County, Iowa.¹²¹

Ella Decker also appears with her parents, William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker, on the 1900 Census for Washington Township, Buchanan County, Iowa. 122 By 1900, William and Eliza listed four children, though the Census also indicates Eliza was the mother of five living children. 123 William is listed as 35 years old and head of household. 124 Eliza is listed as William's wife, age 26. 125 The Census indicates William and Eliza were married nine (9) years. 126 Their children identified in the Census are Nora, age 8, born April 1892; Ella, age 6, born October 1893; Stella, age 5, born October 1894; and Ralph, age 2, born July 1897. 127 All their children are listed as born in Iowa. 128

Ella Decker married George David Miller on November 1, 1910 in Independence, Buchanan County, Iowa. ¹²⁹ At the time George and Ella applied for the marriage license, George was 21 years old, but Ella was only 17. ¹³⁰ Their marriage license was issued on Ella's birthday, October 31, 1910. ¹³¹ According to their Return of Marriage, George would have been 21 at his next birth day and Ella would have been 18. ¹³² Actually, Ella was 18 years old when she married George. She would have been 19 on her next birthday, not 18 as their Return of Marriage indicates. Their marriage was Ella's first ¹³³ and it is assumed their marriage was George's first also since their Return of Marriage does not say. ¹³⁴ Both George and Ella are described as white and living in Independence, Iowa when they married. ¹³⁵ George's occupation is listed as laborer. ¹³⁶ There is no indication of what Ella's occupation was when she married. ¹³⁷ Ella's mother, Mrs. Jane Decker, provided the consent to marriage and was one of the witnesses for the wedding of Georg and Ella. ¹³⁸ The other witness was James McBride, the Justice of the Peace and the person officiating at their wedding. ¹³⁹ Ella's parents are listed as William Decker and Jane Hare. ¹⁴⁰ Ella's place of birth is shown as Independence, Iowa. ¹⁴¹ George Miller's parents are listed as Ira S. Miller and Lucy Owens. ¹⁴² George Miller was born December 26, 1889 ¹⁴³ in Urbana, Benton County, Iowa, ¹⁴⁴ not May 26, 1889 as indicated in the body of text in George's Obituary. ¹⁴⁵

George and Ella (Decker) Miller's children would have had to been born between

George and Ella (Decker) Miller's children would have had to been born between 1910 1914, the date they married and the date Ella died. There were no Miller births, fathered by George Miller, recorded in Fayette County, between the years 1914 1923. However, this could simply be the case of births not being registered, a common practice. The records for "Delayed Births" were not checked for that same time frame.

George D. and Ella (Decker) Miller gave birth to Ira William Miller on November 26, 1911 in Washington Township, Independence, Iowa. ¹⁴⁶ Ira William Miller was George D. and Ella Miller's first child. ¹⁴⁷ Ira's birth record indicates his father was George D. Miller, White, born in Iowa and Luella Decker, White, born in Iowa. ¹⁴⁸ George was 22 years old when Ira was born and Ella was 18. ¹⁴⁹ At the time Ira was born, George D. and Ella Miller's place of residence was Independence, Iowa. ¹⁵⁰ Tragically, Ira William Miller only lived 12 days. ¹⁵¹ Ira died on December 8, 1911 in Oran, Iowa and was buried in Wilson Cemetery, Independence, Iowa on December 8, 1911. ¹⁵² His cause of death is listed as "premature birth - 8 months." ¹⁵³

Ira's death record indicates his father was "J.D. Miller and his mother as Luella Decker.¹⁵⁴ Obviously, Ira's death record contains a typo.¹⁵⁵ The J. D should have been written G. D.¹⁵⁶ George Miller provided the information in Ira's death record, though the record states the informant was J.D. Miller.¹⁵⁷ George and Ella Miller were living in Independence at the time Ira died.¹⁵⁸

George D. and Ella (Decker) Miller had possibly three daughters.¹⁵⁹ Hilda was their daughter who grew to adult-hood.¹⁶⁰ Hilda Jane Miller (b: August 3, 1913 - d: July 3, 2001)¹⁶¹ However, George and Ella possibly had two other daughters who died in infancy.¹⁶² Search results of vital records have accounted for one or possibly two children from George and Ella Decker's marriage.¹⁶³

In 1913, Hilda was born at Brandon, in Buchanan County, located very near the Benton county line. One year later in 1914, both Ella (Decker) Miller and an infant Miller died at Oran Township, Fayette County and both were buried in Fairbank Cemetery.

Infant Miller (b: July 27, 1914 - d: July 29, 1914). ¹⁶⁴ Infant Miller is presumed to be George and Ella Millers child. However, there is no direct evidence that Infant Miller is their child.

Between November 1910 (George and Ella Miller's marriage) and August 1913 (Hilda Miller's birth) there was plenty of time for George and Ella Miller to have had at least one other baby. According to the Wilson Cemetery Listings, a "Baby Miller" is among those buried in Margaret (Preston) (Decker) Fuller's burial lot. There is no further information on Baby Miller. There is no birth or death dates for the baby, and there is no head stone for Baby Miller. There is no birth or death dates for the baby.

Margaret (Preston) (Decker)Fuller is Ella May Miller's paternal grandmother - William Decker's mother. 169 Since Baby Miller is buried with William Henry Decker's mother, it seems likely that Baby Miller would have been a relative of the Decker family. Possibly, Baby Miller is George and Ella Miller's child. Further research is needed to find out who Baby Miller was.

Ella (Decker) Miller may have given birth to a premature child approximately one month prior to Ella' death. ¹⁷⁰ A death record for a two day old "Infant Miller" born July 27, 1914 and who died July 29, 1914 in Oran, Fayette County, Iowa was found. ¹⁷¹ The infant's cause of death is listed as premature birth. ¹⁷² According to the death

record, (which is located on same page as Ella Miller's death record) Infant Miller is buried in Fairbank, Buchanan County, Iowa, ¹⁷³ presumably in the Fairbank cemetery where Ella and George Miller are also buried. ¹⁷⁴ Infant Miller's death record did not list a name for the baby or identify the baby's sex. ¹⁷⁵ Because Infant Miller died at Oran and is buried at Fairbank, presumably the same cemetery as Ella and George Miller, it is believed that this was Ella's child, but there in no direct proof that Infant Miller is Ella's child. Ella Miller died about three weeks later.

A check was then run in the births records for Infant Miller to see if there was a name available, but there was no record of the birth.¹⁷⁶ Therefore, it is also possible that there may not be a record for the mysterious "Baby Miller" who is buried at Wilson Cemetery in Independence. Without dates, it will be difficult to match other records with Baby Miller in order to determine Baby Miller's identity or who Baby Miller's parents were.

George Miller and his daughter, Hilda, lived in Waterloo, Iowa after Ella died. The According to Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns, she stopped to visit George and Hilda in Waterloo after Ella died. Carrie Lucille said, that she probably did not go in the house, but her parents and her grandparents, William and Eliza Decker, did visit with George and Hilda that day. Carrie Lucille when on to say that she did know how long George and his daughter lived in Waterloo.

Ella (Decker) Miller died of pulmonary tuberculosis on August 24, 1914 in Oran, Fayette County, Iowa.¹⁷⁸ when her daughter, Hilda, was one year old¹⁷⁹ and three weeks after presumably giving birth to a premature baby.¹⁸⁰ Ella was only 20 years old when she died.¹⁸¹ She would have been 21 in October 1914.¹⁸² She had only been married to George for three years when she died in August, or four years in November.¹⁸³ No obituary for Ella (Decker) Miller was found.¹⁸⁴ Ella (Decker) Miller is buried in Fairbank, Buchanan County, Iowa.¹⁸⁵ When Ella's

mother, Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker, died in March 1936, Eliza's Obituary stated, "One daughter Ella died on August 26, 1914 at Oran." It is not possible to get pictures of headstones for George and Ella (Miller) Miller. There are no headstones for George and Ella Miller, Infant Miller, Hilda Fox or Marlette Fox all of whom are buried on Lot 166 at Fairbank Cemetery, _____, Iowa. City Hall has their names on file and that will be the only record available for their burials. 189

Lylia Hare walked the Fairbank Cemetery and found Lot 166 and who was buried on it, namely a civil war veteran named Abbott. She used Mr. Abbott's grave as a reference point from which to find the George Miller family graves. There was a large empty space between Mr. Abbotts grave that was listed in the book and the next stone standing. The obvious vacancies were the location of many unmarked graves. After searching several rows on both sides of Mr. Abbott's grave, it was apparent to Ms. Hare that there were no markers for the Miller or Fox graves anywhere nearby. Ms. Hare is totally convinced that the unmarked graves in Lot 16 are those of the George Miller family and daughter, Hilda (Miller) Fox and Hilda (Miller) Fox's daughter, Marlette. Marlette.

George Miller remarried after Ella's death.¹⁹² George's second wife was Mrs. Minnie B. Truair.¹⁹³ Minnie's maiden name was Minnie MacBell Robbins.¹⁹⁴ Her parents were David Bert Van Robbins and her mother was Leah Mae Miller.¹⁹⁵ According to George and Minnie's marriage record, they were married November 13, 1922 in Independence, Iowa.¹⁹⁶

George and Minnie Miller's marriage record indicates both were married once before. ¹⁹⁷ At the time George and Minnie were married, George was a laborer, 33 years old and Minnie was 30 years old. ¹⁹⁸ No occupation was listed for Minnie. ¹⁹⁹ Their marriage record indicates both were White and living in Oelwein, Iowa. ²⁰⁰ Their marriage record indicates George was born in Benton County, Iowa and that his parents were Ira S. Miller and Lucy Owens. ²⁰¹ Their marriage record also indicates Minnie was born in Independence, Iowa and her parents

were David B. Robbins and May Miller.²⁰² The witnesses to their marriage were J.N. Marshall and Leaha M. Truair.²⁰³

George D. Miller died May 6, 1923 at 11:30 a.m. in Oelwein, Fayette Count, Iowa.²⁰⁴ His cause of death was drowning in a cinder pit.²⁰⁵ He was employed for the Chicago Great Western Railroad (CGW) when he died.²⁰⁶ At the time of his death, he was a laborer, 33 years, 4 months and 10 days old.²⁰⁷ George was buried May 8, 1923 in Fairbank Cemetery, Fairbank, Buchanan County, Iowa.²⁰⁸ His death record indicates that George was white, married and born December 26, 1889 in Benton County, Iowa.²⁰⁹ George's father was Ira S. Miller.²¹⁰ Mrs. Minnie Miller of Oelwein, Iowa provided the information for George's death record.²¹¹

There are discrepancies regarding the date on which George Miller died. The Oelwein Daily Register referred to George's death as May 5 (Saturday night),²¹² but George's death record reported his death as occurring on Sunday May 6, 1923 at 11:30 p.m.,²¹³ which seems to be in error based on all the details reported in the newspaper.²¹⁴ According to the Oelwein Daily Register, George was last seen alive 11:00 p.m. Saturday night and he was found some hours later,²¹⁵ possibly around 2:00 Sunday morning. It appears to be uncertain which side of midnight the fatal fall took place, so there really is no way of knowing for sure which date to use for his death. However, it is worth making a note of this conflict and the events surrounding it to better understand the reason for the confusion.

Various newspapers reporting on George Millers death describe conflicting information about George's children. The Oelwein Daily Register, May 7, 1923, reported that "[h]e was married and there are two children."²¹⁶ This reference may have been to George and his second wife, Minnie. In which case, the reference is correct since there were two children: his daughter, Hilda Miller and his stepson, Robert Truair. The Oelwein Daily Register, May 9, 1923, reported that "[h]e was united in marriage to Miss Ella Decker, November 1, 1910 and to this union were born three children, two passing away in infancy."²¹⁷ This reference is also probably correct, i.e., his daughter Hilda Miller, Infant Miller & Baby Miller. Later, in the Obituary, the Oelwein Daily Register, May 9, 1923, says, "[h]e leaves to mourn his loss his loving wife, two children and one stepson, Robert Truair"²¹⁸ This reference is probably incorrect as there probably were only his daughter, Hilda and step-son, Robert. The Bulletin Journal, May 10, 1923, says, "[h]e leaves a wife and three children."²¹⁹ This reference is also probably incorrect as there probably were only his daughter Hilda Miller and step-son, Robert Truair.

However, according to Minnie Miller's granddaughter Pat ______, her grandmother, Minnie, was a "wild child," based on her lifestyle. Pat said, Minnie and George's daughter, Ruthe, was born July 6, 1916, despite the fact that there were no Miller births, fathered by George Miller, recorded in Fayette County, between the years 1914-1923²²⁰ and that George and Minnie did not marry until 1922. As a result, Ruthe could be the third child, and the "sister" referred to in Hilda Fox's obituaries. In reality, Ruthe would have been Hilda's half-sister.

There is an eight year gap between Ella (Decker) Miller's death, August 24, 1914²²¹ and George's marriage to Minnie, November 13, 1922.²²² George and Minnie were only married six months at the time of George's death, May 6, 1923.²²³ Therefore, if they had a child together, the child had to have been born prior to their marriage, or at best, the child had to have been born soon after they married and before George died. Further, if George and Minnie had a child, the child probably would have been George's other child referred to in his obituaries. The childs birth would have been between August 1914 and May 1923. However, as indicated earlier, there were no Miller births, fathered by George Miller, recorded in Fayette County, between the years 1914-1923.²²⁴

Hilda (Miller) Fox's obituary in the Oelwein Daily Register on July 5, 2001 states that Hilda was preceded in death by her parents, "a stepbrother and sister." This reference implies a step-brother and step-sister which means the children where Minnie's children from a previous marriage or the reference implies a step-brother, and a sister. In any case, the reference is probably incorrect because Hilda probably did not have a sister, half-sister or step-sister who survived to adulthood. The Waterloo Courier, July 5, 2001, states Hilda was preceded in death by "a daughter; Marlette Fox; a stepbrother; a sister; and five grandchildren." The wording in the Waterloo Courier clearly indicates that Hilda Fox had a sister, not a step-sister. However, this reference is also probably incorrect because Hilda Miller-Fox probably did not have a sister, half-sister or step-sister.

Hilda Miller was only one year old when her mother died²²⁹ and almost ten years old when her father died.²³⁰ After her father's death, Hilda Miller went to live with her grandparents, William and Eliza Jane Decker, who finished raising her.²³¹ Hilda also lived with her aunt and uncle, Carl Oscar and Nora (Decker) Reinhold, in Medford, Wisconsin for about one year while Hilda was in high school.²³² Carl Oscar and Nora (Decker) Reinold were Carrie Lucille's parents;²³³ and William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker were Carrie Lucille's grandparents.²³⁴

Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns personally knew Hilda (Miller)Fox from at least the time when Hilda was living with their grandparents, William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker,²³⁵ through the date of Hilda's death. Carrie Lucille explained that during the period she knew Hilda, she never heard of Hilda having any living sisters from George and Ella Miller's marriage. Further, Carrie Lucille does not recall George and Minnie Miller having any children, but as she said, "It was a long time ago and I cannot be sure of that either." Carrie Lucille feels certain that if Hilda had a sister, either from George and Ella Miller's marriage or from George and Minnie Miller's marriage, she probably would have heard about the women, and she never did.

News of George Miller's death was published at least five times in three newspapers.²³⁶ The contents of the newspaper clippings have been retyped for clarity and are set forth below. The clippings' formats have been changed to allow them to fit on the page. In addition, the newspapers' names and publication dates have been added. The quality of the image on the microfilm from which the clippings were obtained was so bad that some of the information in the clippings could not be read and therefore, those areas are identified as illegible.²³⁷

George And Luella "Ella" Miller's daughter

Hilda Jane Miller was born August 3, 1913, Brandon, Buchanan County, Iowa.²³⁸ Brandon, Iowa is located very near Benton County, but is actually in Buchanan County.²³⁹ Hilda's marriage record incorrectly reported the location of Brandon as Benton County which is an error.²⁴⁰ Hilda Miller was only one year old when her mother died²⁴¹ and almost ten years old when her father died.²⁴² After her fathers death in May 1923, Hilda Miller went to live with her grandparents, William and Eliza Jane (Hare) Decker, who finished raising her.²⁴³ Hilda also lived with her aunt and uncle, Carl Oscar and Nora (Decker) Reinhold, in Medford, Wisconsin for about one year while Hilda was in high school.²⁴⁴

Hilda Jane Miller married Alvin LeRoy Fox on March 21, 1934 in Oran, Fayette County, Iowa.²⁴⁵ The witnesses to their marriage were Pearle Fuller and Maurice W. Raymond.²⁴⁶ Their marriage was the first for both.²⁴⁷At the time they were married, Hilda would have been 21 on her next birthday and Alvin would have be 21 too.²⁴⁸ Both Hilda and Alvin are identified as white and American born.²⁴⁹ Alvin's occupation is listed as Shop man.²⁵⁰ No occupation is listed for Hilda.²⁵¹ At the time they were married, Alvin was living in Oelwein, Iowa and Hilda was living in Oran, Fayette County Iowa.²⁵² Alvin's parents are identified as Rosia Maybel Carpenter and Lloyd Fox.²⁵³ Alvin's place of birth is identified as Grove Hill Bremer, County, Iowa.²⁵⁴ Hilda's parents are identified

The wound on the head was probably not sufficient in cause death but may have made him unconscious so that his death by drowning would result.

The county coroner was notified and an inquest will be held sometime this afternoon it is expected. Mr. Miller was born in Benton county and was 22 years, four months and 11 days of age at the time of his passing. He was married and there are two children. The family resides at 334 4 42 Street W. Short service will be held from the home Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. and the public funeral will be held from the Presbyterian church at 2 p.m. Interment will take place in Fairbank.

They are buried around the Laurens area.

Fay and Bessie (Decker) Rankin appear of the 1930 Census for Oelwein City, Jefferson Township, Fayette County, Iowa. Fay was 29 years old and identified as head of house. Bessie was 27 and identified as Fay's wife. There were no children listed. Bessie and Fay could both read and write. The Census indicates that Fay was 20 when he married Bessie and Bessie was 18. Bessie was 18. Bessie were born in Iowa. Fay's father was born in Iowa, but his mother was born in Illinois. Bessie's father was born in Pennsylvania and her mother was born in New York. Fay's occupation is listed as brakeman on the railroad. No occupation is listed for Bessie.

Wm Decker signed an Affidavit dated September 2, 1922 stating that George I. George Carpenter, Jr. appears on the 1920 Census for Franklin Township, Bremer County, Iowa. Sea George is shown living with his parents, George, age 71 and Judid M., age 61, and one sister, Maud B., age 16 and a brother, Walter R., age 19. Sea George Carpenter, Jr. was 37 years old and single. The Census was taken in January 1920 and George married Rosa Decker in September 1922. Rose Decker married George Carpenter, an older man and a kindly person.⁵⁸⁸ He loved his young bride, setting her up well financially.⁵⁸⁹ Rose, also known as Rosie, and George Carpenter had one daughter, Evelyn.⁵⁹⁰ George and Rose farmed south of Highway 3, around Fairbanks, Iowa.⁵⁹¹

Evelyn Wauneta Carpenter was born September 23, 1923 in Oelwein, Fayette County, Iowa.⁵⁹² Her parents were George Carpenter a farmer, age 21and Rosie Decker a housewife, age 18.⁵⁹³ George's age as shown on Evelyns birth documents is incorrect.⁵⁹⁴George was 42 years old when Evelyn was born.⁵⁹⁵ Evelyn's birth was describe as legitimate.⁵⁹⁶ George's place of birth was Bremer County, Iowa and Rosie's was Buchanan County, Iowa.⁵⁹⁷

At the time Evelyn was born, George and Rosie Carpenter were living in Fairbank, Iowa. ⁵⁹⁸ Both George and Rosie are described as White in Evelyn's birth record. ⁵⁹⁹

Apparently, Evelyn Wauneta Carpenter married a man with the last name Tharp.⁶⁰⁰ It is unknown where this marriage took place.⁶⁰¹ Possibly, Los Angeles County, California.⁶⁰² However, Evelyn died in Los Angeles County, California.⁶⁰³ The social security death index shows Evelyn's last residence as 91402 Tujunga, Los Angeles County, California.⁶⁰⁴ The index shows that Evelyn was born September 23, 1923 and died in April 1984.⁶⁰⁵ The index indicates Evelyn Tharp's social security number was 485-22-7077 and was issued before 1951.⁶⁰⁶ California Deaths (1940-97) indicates that Evelyn Waunita Tharp was born Sept 23, 1923 in Iowa and died April 28, 1984 in Los Angeles.⁶⁰⁷ Evelyn and her husband had no children in their marriage. Last residence was Tujunga, Los Angeles County, California. California Deaths (1940-97) also indicates that Evelyn's mother's maiden name was Decker and her father's last name was Carpenter.⁶⁰⁸

George and Rosa Carpenter appear on the 1930 Census Franklin Township, Bremer County, Iowa with their daughter, Evelin W.⁶⁰⁹ George was 48 years old and listed as head of house.⁶¹⁰ Rosa B. was 25 and shown as his wife.⁶¹¹ Evelin was 6 years old and listed as their daughter.⁶¹² George and Rosa could read and write.⁶¹³ George's occupation was listed as farmer, general farming, but no occupation is listed for Rosa.⁶¹⁴ Rosa was listed as being born in Iowa.⁶¹⁵ Her father is listed as being born in Illinois and her mother in Nebraska.⁶¹⁶ Evelin is shown as having been born in Iowa.⁶¹⁷

George Israel Carpenter died at his home on September 11, 1956 from coronary occlusion and was buried on September 15, 1956 in Grove Hill Cemetery, rural Oran. ⁶¹⁸ George's residence was 225 8th Ave. S.W., Oelwein,

Fayette County, Iowa where he had lived for 12 years.⁶¹⁹ George was 75 years old, married and retired from farming when he died.⁶²⁰ His death record indicates George was born February 26, 1881 in Bremer County, Iowa and he did not serve in the Armed Forces.⁶²¹ His wife, Mrs. George I. Carpenter provided the information in his death record.⁶²²

After George Carpenter died, Rosie (Decker) (Carpenter) remarried and moved to California to help her daughter, Evelyn, who had a stroke and passed away.⁶²³ Evelyn probably lived in Los Angeles County, California.⁶²⁴ Rosie's second husband's name and anything about him is unknown, other than his last name must have been Law since Rosie's last name was Law when she remarried the third time. Rose (Decker) (Carpenter) (Law) fell in love again with an elderly gentleman by the name of Larry Williams.⁶²⁷ Both were severe diabetics.⁶²⁸ At ages eighty-seven, they moved out of the nursing home and into Larry William's home.⁶²⁹ They were married shortly thereafter.⁶³⁰ However, Rosie and Larry could not take care of themselves.⁶³¹ Rosie became very ill and was returned to the nursing home once more.⁶³² Larry lived with his daughter or daughter-in-law who looked after him.⁶³³ Rose did not have any children from her 2nd & 3rd marriages.⁶³⁴

On September 12, 1991, Lawrence Albert Williams (b: 03/03/1911) and Rosa Bell Law (b: 11/20/1904) applied for a marriage license. At the time they applied for the license, Lawrence and Rosa were living together at 96th Street N.E. Oelwein Iowa. Their Certificate of Marriage dated September 25, 1991 indicates Rosa's birth date was November 20, 1904 and her parents were William Decker and Eliza Jane Hare. Their Marriage Cer-



Siglin.⁶⁶¹ Jacob is identified 75 years old

and as head of household.⁶⁶² His occupation is listed as switchman. Jacob's wife, Cora, is identified as 48 years old with no occupation.⁶⁶³

Since George and Bernice (Decker) Siglin's marriage record indicates that their marriage was George's second and Bernice's first, ⁶⁶⁴ George would have had to marry and divorce his first wife between April 11, 1930, the date the 1930 Census was taken, ⁶⁶⁵ and before March 31, 1934, the day he married Bernice. ⁶⁶⁶

Bernice Decker married George L. Siglin on March 31, 1934 at Cedar heights, Black Hawk County, Iowa. ⁶⁶⁷ The witnesses to their marriage were Harvey B. Decker and Minnie L. Decker, ⁶⁶⁸ Bernice's brother and his wife. Their marriage was George's second and Bernice's first. ⁶⁶⁹ At the time they were married, George was living at R#2, Cedar Falls, Iowa and Bernice was living in Oelwein, Iowa. ⁶⁷⁰ George Siglin would have been 28 years old on his next birthday and Bernice would have been 21 on hers. ⁶⁷¹ Both Bernice and George are identified as White Americans. ⁶⁷² George's occupation is listed as laborer, Raths. ⁶⁷³ George was born in Rogers Mills, Oklahoma and Bernice was born in Fairbanks, Iowa. ⁶⁷⁴ George's parents are identified as Jacob Siglin and Cora Sturch. ⁶⁷⁵ Bernice's parents are identified as Wm Decker and Jane Hare. ⁶⁷⁶

George and Bernice (Decker) Siglin had one daughter.⁶⁷⁷ Shirley June Siglin was born December 14, 1934 in Waterloo, Black Hawk County, Iowa.⁶⁷⁸ Bernice developed severe diabetes with the pregnancy.⁶⁷⁹ At the time of Shirley's birth, Bernice and George were residing at 4907 Randall Street in Waterloo, Iowa.⁶⁸⁰ George Siglin worked in a factory in Waterloo.⁶⁸¹

Carrie Lucille (Reinhold) Kerns worked for George and Bernice Siglin the summer before the birth of their daughter. Also, William and Eliza Jane Decker lived with George and Bernice Siglin before and after the birth of their daughter. However, it is not known how long William and Eliza Jane Decker lived with the Siglins. Siglins.

George and Bernice (Decker) Siglin lived in Waterloo, Iowa.⁶⁸⁵ After their daughter, Shirley, joined the United States Marine Corp., Bernice and George moved to a town near Camp Lejeune, North Caroline.⁶⁸⁶ Shirley was stationed at Camp Lejeune, North Caroline and married a man in the military.⁶⁸⁷ Shirley last name is possibly Trout.

George Siglin passed away when his daughter, Shirley, was in her late thirties.⁶⁸⁸ George died before Bernice and both died close to Camp Lejeune, North Caroline.⁶⁸⁹ George Siglin is buried in one of the Waterloo, Iowa cemeteries, but it is not known where Bernice is buried.⁶⁹⁰

According to the Social Security Death Index, both George and Bernice (Decker) Siglin's last residence was in Swansboro, Onslow County, North Carolina and both of their last benefit payments went to Hubert, Onslow County, North Carolina. ⁶⁹¹ Bernice's social security number was 482-22-0921 and George's was 481-10-8459. ⁶⁹² The Social Security Death Index indicates that George was born April 2, 1905 and died October 1979; and Bernice was born January 29, 1913 and died January 11, 1999. ⁶⁹³ Also, the index indicates that both George and Bernice Siglin's social security numbers were issued in Iowa. ⁶⁹⁴
