Carrie Anderson was born in Krestianstad, Sweden, July 15, 1849, and departed this life November 21, 1927. When twenty-four years of age she came to make her home in America.

On September 10, 1879, at Wyanet, Ill., she was married to Charles O. Reinhold. Four children came to brighten this home, three of whom, together with their father, survive the deceased. These are: Hilma A. Bordwell, Long Beach, Calif.; Carl Oscar, Medford, Wis.; and William Theodore, Winthrop, Iowa. One son, Frank E., preceded his mother in death.
